



Parent teaching guide: Jesus and Nicodemus



What we learned:

Today we learned we can have two birthdays; a physical one and a spiritual one. From the story of Nicodemus, we learned that we must be “born again” to see the kingdom of heaven. That when one is “born again” Jesus comes in and cleans our heart and we are a part of God’s kingdom.



Prayer:

That this week we would have greater understanding of God’s love for us. And that we would take opportunities to share that love with others.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Read the story about Nicodemus found in John 3:1-16. Talk about the story and answer questions about being born again. Tell your child your story of when you were born again. How Jesus changed your life and what he means to you. Be sensitive to where the discussion goes in possibly leading your child to becoming born again or a deeper understanding of God’s love and salvation.
